**Silk Road to the UK**, held on **November 12-13, 2022**, was spearheaded by Dr. Kimberly Tan and Dr. Aman Arora, where students had the chance to ask all about the pathway to the UK.

Dr. Kimberly Tan, an international medical graduate (IMG) and the co-founder of thesavvyimg.co.uk, explained the eligibility criteria for specialty training and how to become a GP in the UK. As she passed on her experience as an IMG, she also explained how to improve the assessment score for the UK Foundation Program and how vital the Situational Judgement Test.

Dr. Arman Arora, the founder of aroramedicaleducation.co.uk, spoke on PLAB and UKMLA. He gave a detailed explanation of the preparations for the exams, including the most recent guidelines, the advantages of peer support, and using different question banks. He emphasized honing skills and practicing scenarios with colleagues with utmost importance. Knowing the technique of how to showcase as many skills as possible in those 8 minutes is the key to success.

Dr. Yang kicked off with the thought-provoking question, "Is this for me?" citing financial burdens and hard statistics on the success rates for IMGs hoping to make it into the US medical scene. While solemn, he was encouraging, providing realistic advice and warmly answering the attendees' many questions.






#### November 26, 2022:
